

Circus drive:

An open air circus show : an aerial act on the silks

Conceived for rural areas and little towns.

Technically simple, solidary and economic.

Inspired from open air cinema sessions and in order to adapt ourselves to the current situation the audience remains in the car while the performance. Pedestrians and cyclists are also welcome of course ! The advantage of having silks rigged at 8m high is that the visibility is very good even if the audience is far.

To rig the silks in open air you normally need a structure anchored to the floor, and that is not always available. The solution is to borrow a telescopic crane to a local farmer ; we create a link with the local population and reduce costs.

The artists can then arrive tour by public transports with no need to drive a big vehicle with the portico.

The time for the set up and the pull down is reduced, farmers and artists have coproduced and created the big event in town.

Technical needs:

- A flat ground ( if possible protected from big winds).
- Sound equipment
- Time needed to set up: 2 h.
- Time to pull down : 15 minutes.
